Registration can also be done by [paper form](#) that can be downloaded and emailed to publiccomment@clevelandcitycouncil.org. Paper forms will also be available at Council offices. The entire registration form must be completed, including stating the topic they are commenting on.

Those wishing to make a public comment can sign up starting **Wednesday, Sept. 29th at noon**. Registrations prior to noon Wednesday **will not** be considered.

Registration for public comment will close at 2 pm on the Monday of a regular 7 pm Council meeting, for this meeting that is Oct. 4th. (And it will be open the same time for every subsequent meeting.)

Ten people will be able to speak for up to three minutes. If more than 10 people register during the open time, anyone after those 10 will be notified that they will not have an opportunity to speak at the meeting. There is no rollover list, so if someone missed out on the opportunity they will have to register for the following week.

Those wishing to submit written comments, but not speak publicly, can do so on the online form. Or they can email their statements to publiccomment@clevelandcitycouncil.org.
