Resolved, by the Board of Control of the City of Cleveland that the bid of Gene Ptacek & Son Fire Equipment Company, Inc., for an estimated quantity of labor and material necessary to repair or replace fire extinguishers, for all items, for the various divisions of City government, for the period of two years beginning with the date of execution of the contract, received on May 20, 2009, under the authority of Section 181.101 of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, which on the basis of the estimated quantity would amount to \$11,480.90, is affirmed and approved as the lowest and best bid, and the Director of Finance is requested to enter into a requirement contract for the goods and/or services, which shall provide for the immediate purchase as the initial amount of the contract of the following:

Whereas, the Citywide Geographic Information System runs on the Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc. (ESRI) software platform and, support maintenance and licenses must be renewed annually for proper use and support of the

citywide GIS software and applications; now therefore,

Be it resolved by the Board of Control of the City of Cleveland, that under Section 181.102 (b) of the Codified Ordinances of Cleveland, Ohio, 1976, Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc. (ESRI) is selected upon the nomination of the Director of Public Utilities, as determined after a full and complete canvass, as the firm to be employed by contract for a period of one year to provide the professional services necessary for annual software renewal, support and maintenance to the citywide GIS software and applications.

Be it further resolved that the Director of Public Utilities is authorized to enter into contract with Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc., based on its proposal dated February 3, 2009, for the one year period commencing May 16, 2009, which contract shall provide for the furnishing of professional services as described in the proposal, for a fee not to exceed \$211,395.05.
